THE WORK OF THE CHURCH CONTINUES....



Two concert waltzes for piano this week—that is, music intended for solo performance, not dancing. Both composers annotated their scores with expressive tempo changes—pauses, accelerations, etc.—that would have disrupted actual dancers.

Frédéric Chopin (1810-1849), Waltz in B minor, Op. 69, no. 2

Composed in 1829, when the composer was 19, but not published until 1852.


